## **PRSSA Charter Requirements**



The following charter requirements are in accordance with PRSA bylaws and PRSSA National bylaws. If you have questions about these requirements, contact PRSSA Headquarters at (212) 460-1474.

# **School Requirements**

A PRSSA Chapter may be established and maintained only at a college or university that:

- Offers baccalaureate degrees.
- Is accredited by a nationally or regionally recognized accrediting association or board.
- Offers a sequence of at least five courses in public relations.
- Is supplemented by additional courses allied to this field of study.

### **Required Courses**

While PRSA does not try to characterize the specific nature of the required public relations courses, we do require proof of courses addressing the following subject areas:

- Introduction to Public Relations
- Public Relations Writing and Production
- Public Relations Research
- Public Relations Strategy and Implementation (e.g. Case Problems, Campaigns Course)
- Supervised Public Relations Experience (Internship)

# **Endorsement**

Each PRSSA charter application must be endorsed by the president and four additional members of a PRSA sponsor Chapter. You can find the contact information for PRSA Chapters on the PRSA website.

#### **Students**

At least ten students who will join the Chapter are required. Eight must be at or below the junior level.

#### **Faculty Adviser**

A Chapter must have a Faculty Adviser who teaches at least one of the public relations courses required for the charter and who is a PRSA member or Associate Member.

#### **Professional Adviser**

A Chapter must have one or two Professional Advisers who are PRSA members with at least five years of public relations experience or Accreditation. Associate Members do not qualify for this position.

#### Application

To apply, schools must submit the following:

- A non-refundable application fee of \$100, payable to PRSSA.
- Two copies of the completed application and proposed bylaws.
- Two copies of each syllabus for the required public relations courses.
- Two copies of the teacher biographies.
