Changes in the size or format of this form will be grounds for disqualification. Supplementary pages will not be accepted. (Assembly Guidelines, Article II, Section A, Point 1)
- Essay Topic: Describe your leadership style and how it would benefit PRSSA. Use specific examples. 250-words, typed. (Assembly Guidelines, Article II, Section A, Point 2)
- Letter of Recommendation One letter only from candidate's Faculty or Professional Adviser.
- Video of Candidate speech/presentation Make sure to state your full name, school, and the position you are running for at the beginning of the video. Remember, the National President candidate(s) can present for ten minutes, all other candidates can only present for five minutes. Videos must be submitted in the following formats: MOV, MP4, AVI, WMV; other formats will not be accepted.

All materials and the video must be uploaded to this folder by 2 p.m. ET on Monday, March 9. Faxed, emailed or mailed forms will not be accepted. Please type.
