



## PRSA Foundation Student Leadership Assembly Travel Grant 2024

This grant was created to encourage and support multicultural students majoring in public relations and related fields who plan to pursue a career in public relations. The grant will support multicultural students attending the PRSSA Leadership Assembly, March 7–9, 2024 in Seattle, Washington. The grant will be used to cover Travel – Airfare to and from Leadership Assembly, up to \$500.

#### Description

Each year, the PRSSA Leadership Assembly gathers to make influential, long-term decisions about the future of the Society, elect a new National Committee and review the bylaws. In addition, those who attend engage in leadership training and networking.

#### **Application Requirements**

## Applicants must be current members of a PRSSA Chapter that is in good standing. Applicants must also already be registered for the PRSSA Leadership Assembly.

- A maximum of five students will be selected for this grant.

#### **Application Requirements**

- Submit a completed application.
- Submit a typed, double-spaced essay of no more than 200 words on why it would be beneficial for you to attend this Event.

#### Additional Requirements after Assembly

- Student will be required to write a blog post about their experience for the PRSSA blog and the PRSA and PRSA Foundation websites.
- Additionally, students will be required to offer a presentation during a meeting on their campus to discuss what they learned during the Assembly. This should take place before May 31, 2024.
